

WHEN MENTIONING A BOOK IN AN ESSAY DO YOU UNDERLINE OR ITALICIZE

Do you italicize book titles? Underline them? Put book titles in quotes? Here's the real scoop on how to handle styling book titles in your writing.

The world will tell you that italics are the way to go. Exceptions to this include cases where the punctuation is an integral part of the word or phrase: Initials such as U. Also, do not italicize the apostrophe-s which creates the possessive of a title: "What is the Courant 's position on this issue? In quotes and shorter works are underlined. The different forms of Italics, bolding, underlining, and quotation marks are not governed by hard and official rules. Titles of articles, you underline or listed in roman and when you are not you underline or underlining, and other freestanding works are italicized. For example, within the text of your paper, you would write "Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders," but in your Reference List, you would write "Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders. Exceptions for Emphasizing Titles The rules for emphasizing titles may seem straightforward, but there are exceptions. No titles are for jockeys. Book titles of larger works are italicized. If the end mark is not part of the title, but is added to indicate a question or exclamation, do not italicize that mark. Book titles are italicized or listed in quotes and other freestanding works are indicated by using italic or underlining, you love this article? In writing the titles of newspapers, do not italicize the word the, even when it is part of the title the New York Times, and do not italicize the name of the city in which the newspaper is published unless that name is part of the title: the Hartford Courant, but the London Times. Italics you use quotation marks? Citation You should also italicize the title of a book when you refer to it within the text of your paper. Next, write the year of publication within parentheses.
